Hours are Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

This emergency department stabilizes and treats all individuals regardless of their insurance status or ability to pay in accordance with federal law. These prices represent the maximum charge that any patient will be billed for the service. The actual charge for any health care service rendered may be lower depending on applicable health insurance benefits and the availability of discounts or financial assistance.

A facility fee will also be assessed for your care based on how much care is needed. The levels, with level 1 representing basic emergency care, reflect the type of accommodations needed, the personnel resources, the intensity of care and the amount of time needed to provide treatment. Facility fees at this emergency department range from \$322 (Level 1) to \$3,733 (Level 5).
